The Most Holy Trinity - May 27, 2018



In speaking of the Trinity, we are not speaking about some strange doctrine, but about the loving God Who has revealed Himself to us and, like any father here on earth, Who wants his children to know Him. God has revealed to us that He is a Trinity of Persons yet one God! It is a mystery, yet God has revealed this about Himself, so it is not un-important! And God has revealed some very important things that we need to know about *ourselves*! In the beginning, God created us in His image and likeness! God looked at everything he had made, and He found it very good. And the Lord God said: "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a suitable partner for him." And God created Eve, the perfect match for Adam, a marriage made in Heaven. The Book of Genesis tells us that in marriage, the two of them become one body. This tells us something about ourselves and about God. God, in Himself, is a community of persons, yet He is one. And the basic unit of society, that is, the family, is a community of persons as well. God the Father, and God the Son love each other with a perfect love which pours out in the Spirit. A husband and wife love each other and, being created in the image and likeness of God, their love also brings new life into the world: their children! It pleases God to have us know this about Him, and to believe in the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
